2025-2026 Concert Choir Attire Guidelines

Ladies

Members of the choir should wear the designated uniform.

- Black glitter drape front jacket with a $\frac{3}{4}$ length sleeve
- Black floor-length sleeveless knit shell dress
- Black stockings
- Black closed-toe dress shoes
- Small stud earrings; no necklace



New members will need to get sized for the uniform so we can order them. This takes 8-12 weeks. In the event we won't have them in time for your first concert, you'll need to arrange an outfit for the concert. You may already have something in your closet that will work! You can achieve a coordinating look with:

- Black floor-length dress or skirt; palazzo pants are acceptable.
- Cardigan/jacket/blouse with sleeves.
- No jacket? No problem! A dress or blouse with $\frac{3}{4}$ length or long sleeves works. A short sleeve will be acceptable if needed, but the attire must have sleeves.
- Avoid sleeveless, sheer, low-cut, or "skinny"/tight/form-fitting apparel
- Sparkles are not required.
- Black dress shoes, with a black sole, closed toe.
- Conservative earrings are allowed but not required; it should not draw attention. Stud earrings preferred. No necklace.

Please note: Those who join us for the Holiday Singing Session should plan to arrange an outfit according to these guidelines above. We do not require those joining only for the Holiday Singing Session to order the uniform.

Gentlemen

You need to acquire and wear the following:

- black tuxedo jacket
- black tuxedo trousers
- white tuxedo shirt, wing collar
- black bowtie
- black cummerbund
- black button studs
- black socks
- black dress shoes (with a black sole!)
